


What Is The Sustainable Millennium Project?



The Sustainable Millennium Project is based at Selwood Middle School, Frome.

*It was set up in response to Agenda 21 of the Rio Earth Summit.

*Its purpose is to provide Education for Sustainable Development.

In 1995, Selwood School and the Sustainable Millennium Project won the Worldwide Fund For Nature (WWF) Curriculum Management Award. The project is now working in partnership with WWF.

What is Education for Sustainable Development?

*It is NOT about conserving wildlife or developing nature areas, although such activities might well be part of it as ecologically sound living is an essential part of sustainable development.

*It is about understanding the key concepts of the cycling of materials and the flow of energy in such a way that appropriate technologies are developed for the next millennium. It includes social concerns and global justice.

*It is recognized when the quality of human life improves without harming other life forms, compromising the needs of future generations or degrading the physical and human environment.
